## **Arizona Workers' Compensation & Unemployment Insurance**

### Worker's Compensation

Benefit Limitations	None-Lifetime medical & indemnity
Cap Based on Percent of *SAWW	57%
Taxable Base	\$2,400 weekly/\$28,000 annually
Maximum Weekly Benefit	\$374

### Unemployment Insurance

Taxable Base	\$7,000
Rate %	1.48%
Average Among Existing Employers	.82% on first \$7,000 per employee=\$57.40
Average Among New Employers	2.70%
New Employer Starting Rate	2.00%
Maximum Weekly Benefit	\$240
Average Weekly Benefit	\$200.27

*Arizona continues to have the 49th lowest workers' compensation expense in the United States. Participants claim the low maximum serves as a significant motivator to remain on the job or return as soon as possible. However, the Arizona system places no limits on reopening a claim, meaning claimants can receive medical benefits and liability for indemnity for life.*
