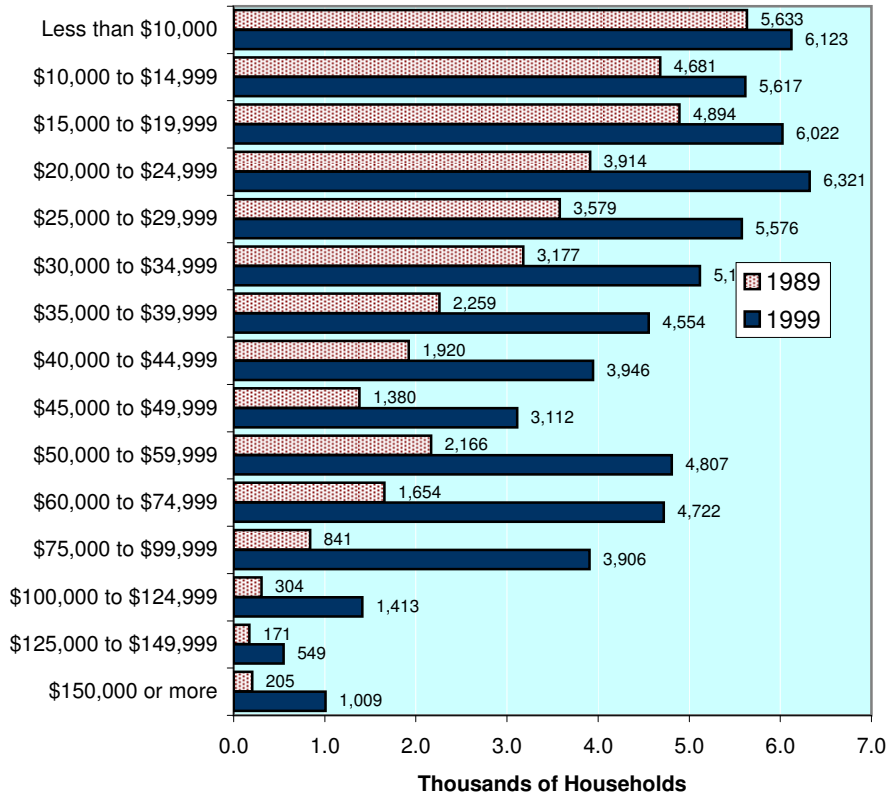


Income Distribution

- In 1999, 47% of households earned less than \$30K, down from 62% of households in 1989. *
- In 1999, 5% of households earned more than \$100K, up from 2% of households in 1989. *
- In 1999, the income bracket with the largest number of households was "\$20,000 to \$24,999". *
- In 1989, the largest bracket was "Less than \$10,000". *

- Median Household Income In 1989 was \$24,002 (\$00 adjusted for inflation in 1999 dollars).*
