- Race and Ethnicity are broken out separately. The Ethnicity breakout is separate because Hispanics can be of any race.

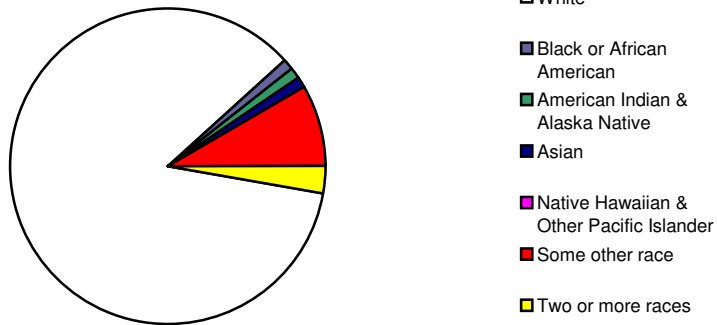

- 20.2% of the population is Hispanic or Latino (of any race).
- Of Hispanic or Latino people, the largest number are "White alone" (50.4% of the Hispanic population).
