- Race and Ethnicity are broken out separately. The Ethnicity breakout is separate because Hispanics can be of any race.

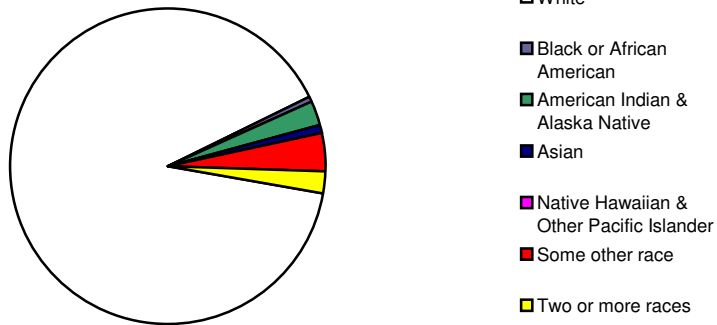
